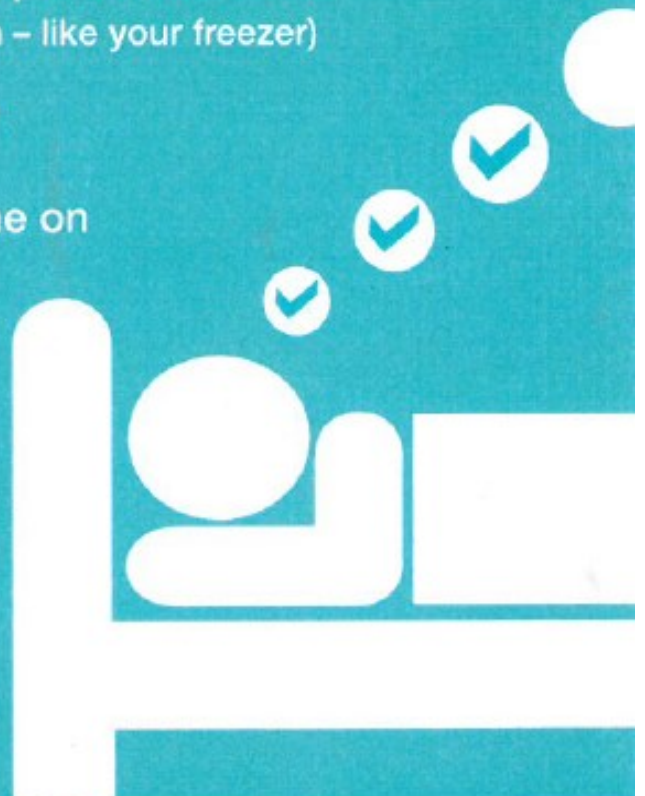
It's not just stories that are for bedtime

- ☐ Close inside doors at night

(unless they are designed to be left on – like your freezer)

- ☐ Don't leave the washing machine on
- ☐ Turn heaters off
- ☐ Put candles and cigarettes
out properly
- ☐ Make sure exits are kept clear
- ☐ Keep door and window keys
where everyone can find them
