



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May 2024 Household Support Fund update

On 6 March 2024 the Chancellor of the Exchequer, Rt Hon Jeremy Hunt MP, presented his Spring Budget to Parliament. The Chancellor confirmed that the Household Support Fund (HSF) would be extended for a further six months from 1 April 2024 to 30 September 2024. Since this announcement Cheshire East have been working at pace to develop a new support package, ensuring that it goes to those most in need of financial support.

On 29 April the Children and Families Committee endorsed the new HSF support package. Schools can now access, through a referral process and a new HSF Decision Panel, a range of support for financially vulnerable adults, children and their families living in Cheshire East. Referrals can be made for food and Energy support, based on household composition, financial support for wider essentials, up to the cost of £500.00 and financial assistance for exceptional costs, over £500.00

School Communications and Payments Update

From September 2024, we will be changing the way we send communications and moving to online bookings for School Meals and Wraparound care.

We will be sending communications to you via the School Spider App and email. We encourage you to download the School Spider Parent App for instant notifications, please see the guidance at-tached.

We will continue to use SchoolMoney for online payments and will be moving to online bookings for Dinners and Wraparound Care. These will have to be paid for at the time of booking or you will need sufficient credit in top up for childcare vouchers if this is your method of payment.

This will allow sufficient time to bring your accounts up to date or build a credit balance before we begin the new system in September. We will issue further details before the end of July.

School meal changes

Following communication recently from Cheshire East Catering I am writing to update you on some changes to the school catering service provided by Cheshire East Council. For many years, Cheshire East staff have ensured that high quality school meals are provided to children and young people across the schools within RCSAT and across Cheshire East.

However, over recent years, there have been increasing financial pressures in running this service due to both food and transport inflation and pay rises that have impacted on their running costs. This has led to the council providing a significant subsidy towards school meal costs. This is not a service that the council must provide and, given their current financial position, is not one that they can sustain. Therefore, it is with regret that the council has decided to cease trading its school catering service by April 2025.

As the council, has removed its subsidy to the school catering service for this financial year and, despite making all available savings, they will need to significantly increase the charge made to schools to provide a school meal from September 2024 to March 2025.

Therefore, the cost of a school meal from 2^{nd} September 2024 will be £3.20.

As a trust, we are currently looking for a future option that provides a more cost-effective school meal service in the longer term. In the meantime, we hope that you will continue to support the Cheshire East school meal service that is doing the best it can to provide your child with a healthy and nutritious meal.

PENALTY NOTICE FINES FOR SCHOOL ATTENDANCE ARE CHANGING !

With the introduction of the new National Framework for Penalty Notices, the following changes will come into force on 19 August 2024.

Penalty Notices will be issued for

Term time leave: Penalty Notice fines will be issued for term time leave of 5 or more consecutive days.

10 Sessions of Unauthorised absence in a rolling 10 week period: A Penalty Notices may be considered when there have been 10 sessions of unauthorised absences in a 10 week period.

However, we retain the discretion to issue a Penalty Notice before the threshold is met. For example, where parents are deliberately avoiding the national threshold by taking several term time holidays below the above thresholds.

Per Parent/Per Child

Penalty Notice fines will continue to be issued per parent per child. For example: 3 siblings absent for term time leave, would result in each parent receiving 3 separate fines.

First Offence

The first time a Penalty Notice is issued for term time leave or irregular school attendance the fine will be charged at:

£160 per parent, per child if paid within 28 days of the issue, reducing to £80 per parent, per child if paid within 21 days.

(Unpaid penalty notices may result in a parental prosecution)

Second Offence

Where it is deemed appropriate to issue a second penalty notice to the same parent for the same pupil within 3 years of the first penalty notice, for either term time leave or irregular attendance the second penalty notice will be charged at:

£160 if paid within 28 days. (Unpaid penalty notices may result in a parental prosecution)

Third Offence

On the third time that an offence is committed within 3 years of the first penalty notice for either a term time leave or irregular attendance a penalty notice will not be issued. The case may proceed to Parental Prosecution under the Single Justice Procedure. If found guilty of the offence of 'Failure to send a child to school' the Magistrates can impose a fine up to £1000 or legal proceedings under Section444 (1a) can include a fine of up to £2500.
