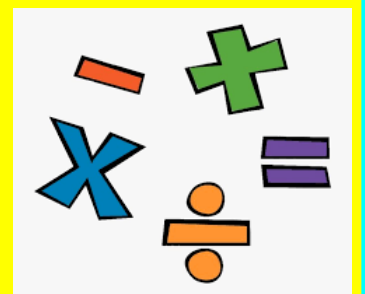
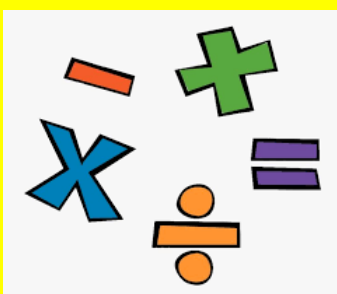

Parents Evening
